



# Philadelphia Walk Details

## Where do we walk?

The Philadelphia Zoo walk is so much fun! The walk is right through the zoo and walkers have a choice of taking 1 or 2 laps for about 1.5-3 miles. The zoo is open to the public on walk day, but we reserve the Peacock Pavilion and Impala Lawn areas for registration, refreshments, entertainment and all those other walk day festivities.

## Raise Funds

We have been encouraging everyone to start their fundraising early this year so we can raise as much as possible to help fight CF! Please find included some fund-raising ideas for you and your team members. The average walker raises more than \$350! Set your fundraising goal and ask everyone you know to help you reach it. Online fundraising is fast and effective - simply email everyone you know and ask for their support!

## Zoo Admission

**All fundraising walkers, including children Age 2 and up, that PRE-REGISTER by April 1 will receive complimentary admission into the Zoo. Fundraising walkers meeting the April 1 deadline can pick-up their complimentary tickets at the Great Strides Pre-Collection Party, Saturday, April 24 at the CFF Office in Broomall, PA. \*\*All fundraising walkers that register after April 1, will be asked to make a \$15 donation on walk day to the CFF to help cover their admission cost.\*\* Only children Age 1 and younger get in to the zoo free.**

# Directions & Transportation

The Philadelphia Zoo is located at the corner of 34th Street and Girard Avenue in Philadelphia's historic Fairmount Park, the world's largest landscaped city park. The Zoo is just two miles from downtown Philadelphia and easily accessible by car from the Schuylkill Expressway (I-76). Parking is available along Girard Avenue at 35th and 38th Streets. Additional parking is available at the south end of the Zoo. Public Transportation is available using SEPTA, which runs several bus routes to the Zoo area.

## Driving Directions

### From the East

Access Interstate-76 by exiting PA Turnpike at Neshaminy. Take US RT1-S to 76E. Take Interstate-76 to exit 342 Girard Avenue. Turn left at Girard Avenue for parking.

### From the West

Access Interstate-76 by exiting PA Turnpike at Valley Forge. Follow 76 to exit 342 Girard Avenue. Follow directional signs to turn left or right on Girard Avenue for available parking.

### From Center City

Take the West River Drive to Sweetbriar Drive and turn left. At South Concourse Drive, turn left and go one block to Girard Avenue. To park, turn right on Girard Avenue or continue straight to the Tiger parking lot. Note that on weekends from April through October, West River Drive is closed at certain times to vehicular traffic. During this period, follow the above driving directions from the east.

## Public Transportation

It's easy to get to the Zoo on public transit. We're served by the #38 bus and the route #15 trolley. Get more information about public transportation at the SEPTA website, [www.septa.org](http://www.septa.org).

## Parking Map

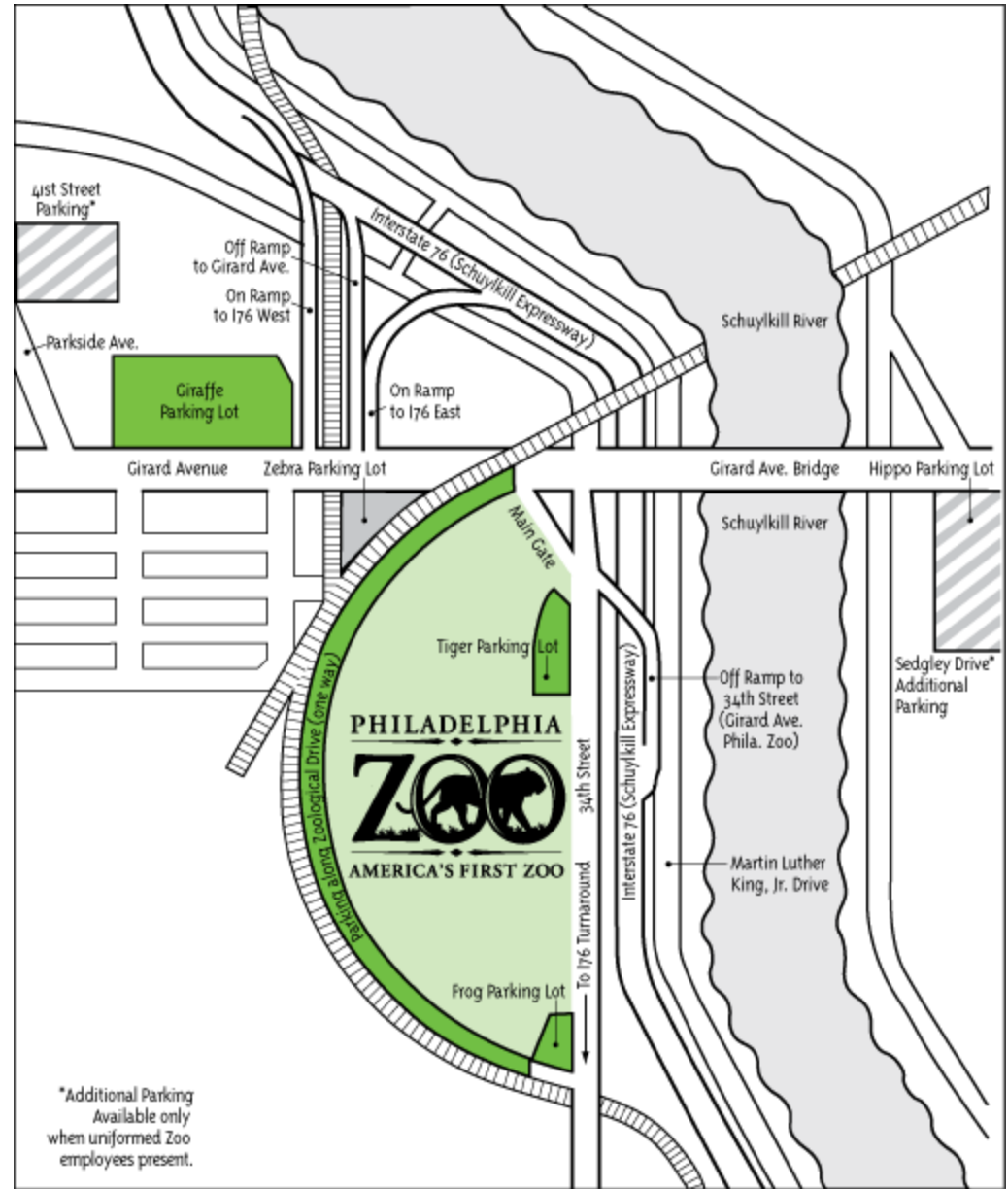
There is Zoo parking along both Girard Avenue and 34th Street. Parking in a Zoo lot will cost \$12, but members with proper I.D. park for free.

Parking is available in the following lots:

- Giraffe Parking Lot – Girard Ave.
- Zebra Parking Lot – Girard Ave.
- Frog Parking Lot – 34<sup>th</sup> Street

### Additional Parking:

- Hippo Parking Lot – Girard Avenue
- 41<sup>st</sup> Street Parking Lot – 41<sup>st</sup> Street
