A Tennis Auction Ball April 24, 2010

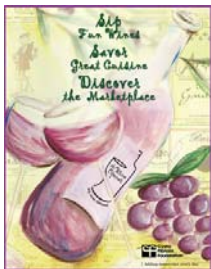
