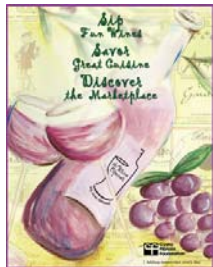
Grand Chefs Gala January 29, 2010

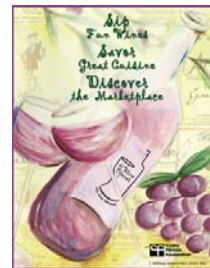
